Synthèse des jugements individuels Individual judgments' overview

42 siamese, balinese, oriental long- and shorthair were presents.

My overall impression was that the cats were in great condition, clean and well presented and of very nice character in general.

I was happy with the general quality in type, size and colours, and was VERY impressed by one of the breeder groups of which the eldest cat was 7 years of age, a super seal point colourwise, who produced a spectacular 4 years old daughter with deep seal points, all regular developed in colour, lovely deer coloured even body colour and the one and only true eye colour for siamese: DEEP, VIOLET BLUE!! The third generation of this group showed a seal tabby point, stunning in type, exceptional in point colour again, with lovely deep blue eyes who ended up as best female. An ebony with the best coat ever, super tight and very short and glossy, and a bicolour black and white. This group was shown in excellent condition, super bodie shapes and firm muscle tone, strong and athletic, well balanced and harmonious.

The selection of siamese overall was very good, with one or two exceptions, where it was obviously one line in which eye colour was not paid attention to.

The oriental shorthair overall, were of excellent quality, especially a brown tabby with the only true colour a brown tabby should have: a warm brown base colour with jet black markings. He was best male, best shorthair and best in the top 10. This cat should be an example to breed towards. His colour I have only seen in the very beginning of this variety, many, many years ago.

Lovely examples of the breed in general, with one or two exceptions were the presented cats were too small - attention needs to be paid to the fact that - refined as the standard calls for - does not mean small or skinny. A beautiful cat is always only beautiful when it radiates health, muscle tone, is clean and has good weight to the body.

Very impressed by a black tabby veteran of 10 years. Strong, healthy and of excellent type. He was best Veteran, Best Honour class and ended up in the top 10.

Synthèse des jugements des vétérans Veterans judgments' overview

4 cats presented in overall good condition. Very well cared for, with in some case a bit to much weight.

The chocolate Mandarin 8+ years, was overall well balances, if not a tad too heavy, great coat length in very good show condition. A warm chocolate colour in tone, slight undercoat. Good te, with modest but balanced wedge, fitting the overall cat.

The lilac mackerel of 7 years had a super lilac tone, needs more contrast in tabby markings, but coat was soft and flowing and well presented. Modest wedge here again, in general, type could be improved in the longhair variety.

A seal point of 6 years needed more type and style, as this show had some lovely examples of the oldest siamese breed. They are the basis of our today's siamese and orientals.

The best of the veterans was obviously the 10 years old black spotted tabby with big, but so balanced body - tail - legs, super short rich colour coat, with excellent markings. He was best Veteran, Best Honour and nominated for best male. Also made it into the top 10. Well done.

Synthèse des jugements des groupes 3 générations 3-generations judgments' overview

An impressive group.

The Grand Mere nr 150 was a well balanced but modest type seal point with spectacular dark and even seal points on all legs, tail and mask. Wonderful deer coloured body colour without ghostmarkings or flacky colourspots.

Super deep blue eyes, which she passed on to her daughter nr 147, who became best seal point of the day, with a wonderful refined type, not extreme but so super balanced with a lovely long wedge with clean lines, super refined muzzle, and the same spectacular seal points and deep, deep blue eyes. She was my favourite, the cat I would wanted to take home.

Her daughter nr 146 had the type we want for the show, therefore I nominated her for Best female, but the finesse of 147 tickled my heart.

Nr. 145 the black and white bicolour, her sister was also very good, with a balanced head and great tuxedo markings. I preferred the tabby point as she again had this spectacular points, body colour and deep blue eye colour.

The oriental black nr. 148 had the same type as generation three, again a super colour, deep, deep black, very short and glossy coat, excellent type and body type, unfortunately his eye colour needs to be greener.

Overall this group made my day. Well done to the breeder.

Synthèse des jugements 3 descendants d'un même reproducteur Breeding groups judgments' overview

Lot A: père Leonidas du Quai des Cygnes (absent) - 4 descendants issus de 3 mères (4 portées)

The development in this group was not obvious and the types all different. No persistence in lines.

Nr. 72 a lilac point of 2,5 years needs to have much better eye colour, and attention has to be paid to the strabismus. A CAC was given but further I could not see him go.

Nr. 71 a seal point and white female of 1,2 year was quite small, her body tone was good, well balanced and in proportion but too small for age. The white percentage was borderline and for further breeding a cross to bicolour only would be advisable in order not to lose the white.

Nr. 228 a seal point of 1,1 year did get exc 2 but needs more overall type, like nr 227 also a balanced seal point girl of 1,2 years but all relatively small for age. Attention to type and size needs to be paid at.

Lot B: mère Mogwai de Techoueyres (présente) - 3 descendants issus de 2 pères (2 portées)

I could repeat the above report, nr 147 and her 3 descendants obviously became my best group of the day, from this group the improvements made during the generaties were fixed and passed on the good points. I can only repeat that to give my compliment to the breeder and respect for the work she has done.

General show impression

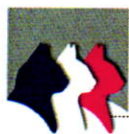
