Headtype

Very constant in about 90 percent of the cats.

Great wedges, with balanced ears. Excellent eyeshapes and mostle good eyecolour. No disqualifying faults

Body

Again super elegant in almost all of the exhibited cats.

Excl. muscletone, elegant legs and feet, super in colour.

Coats

High number of cats had excellent coats, in length, texture, pattern and colour

Condition

With one or two exceptions all presented cats were in super showcondition

Globale

Never experienced this level of quality!!!!

A very impressive, balanced and elegant group

Nr. 75 Mise a feu de l'Improbable as 1st generation, passed on his wonderfull, stylish type to both his daughter and his granddaughter. Extremely stunning in coatcolour, super ticked body without any ghostmarkings, double necklace and ringed and ringed tail.

Nr. 86 - Daughter Tiyi de Vedrarias, lilac tabby point maintained the type both in headtype as in bodyelegance. Super soft, pinkish lilac in colour, supurbe eyeshape, setting and form. Lovely deep eyecolour.

Nr. 88 Granddaughter Zita de Vedrarias, had the longest headlength with, what I find super important, a long straight nose. The length of the nose being the same length as bridge to tophead length giving it a super balanced headtype. Big ears set in the clean lines of the wedge, excellent eyeset and deep blue siamese eyecolour.

Truly a lovely group of three generations of selecting and improving and maintaining the overal balance and type

## Synthèse des jugements des vétérans

5 cats presented in the Veterans group.

In 3 cases I withheld the certificates simply because they were in high classes (in one case CACE) and a combination with type and or condition, it did not justify awarding them. On the show I explained why I withheld to the exhibitors.

Sometimes breeders/owners need to see where the maximum title lies for their cats. It takes a critical eye, but for succes one needs to be critical, always look for improving the breed, maintaining the good points, improving the lesser.

The absolute winner was also Best Class de Honeur, nr. 76 Nakao du Val d'Ancoeur a super chocolate spotted and white bicolour. He was later among the selection for best in show, but because of the overal super quality of his competitors he did not end up there.

Conclusion is that two out of five were of super show quality.

### ➤ Commentaire / Appréciation général(e) / General show impression

I am so grateful to all the exhibitors, owners and breeders for giving me the experience of judging 39 cats of my beloved group of cats, that were (with a few exceptions) of the highest quality. I can honestly say I have never, EVER seen this high level of Orientals, Siamese and Peterbalds, AND in this number in ONE show.

Almost all were potential winners

During the day I simply could not believe that every cat I judged was of this overall super balanced type. In cases where small improvements could be made, I experienced an eagerness to learn and listen and take advice by the all the exhibitors.

Also that most of them had a good idea of future combinations and already a breeding plan for the direction they had to go in finding the right combinations.

A super awareness of what the breed needs. The atmosphere amongst the exhibitors was evident. It is so important to place the breed always before one's own ego and always work towards the standard, and to work together.

When I had my first litter of chocolate point siameses, over 50 years ago, we only had Seal-, Chocolate-, Bleu- and lilac point siameses on the shows, and an occasional oriental havanna and ebony (as they were called).

End 70ties - with a group of friends - we started the breed of oriental silver tabbies and smokes. When they were recognized eventually, I thought it best to find another challenge: the oriental bicolors with my ultimate dream: a lilac tortie and white Van

I never ever produced one, I came close when I had a black tortie harlequin.

All through those breeding programs, I worked together with friends.

Planning the breed, never our ego in the way. Placing kittens in loving families on "breeding terms", getting a kitten back to continue the lines. Selecting and importing new lines. We formed a family, an international group of strong connected friendships.

We all were "living and breathing our breed". None of us is breeding anymore, but we are still family.

Truly, for the first time ever, I saw that same spirit in Irún. Also how far the breed has come, it gave us also the magnificent Peterbalds and who know what the genes still have hidden for us.

To the exhibitors and breeders I like to say: I am so excited for your future and wish you so much luck and love and passion

Once again: from the bottom of my heart: Thank you for giving me the opportunity, the pleasure and the emotions to handle your beautiful cats.
